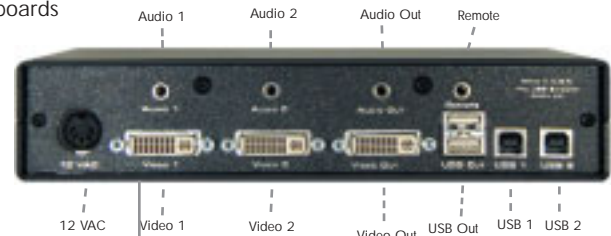
How it works

To switch, press the button in the front of the USB-Switcher or switch remotely using Gefen's RMT-2 remote control.
